



EYE AND EAR PROTECTION SHOULD BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

Tools Required:




Kit Contents:

- 16m x 2m Polymesh
- 100 cable ties
- 25m galvanised wire
- 20 heavy duty screw eyes
- 20 rawl plugs
- 2 barrel adjusters




1.

Plan out enclosure.
Mark out all screw eye positions all around the balcony*




2.

Fix screw eyes to the wall/floor/ceiling
with rawl plugs




3a.

Thread the wire through
all of the screw eyes.
Tie each open end to the
wire tensioner.




3b.

Tension the wire, making it as
tight as possible




4.

Unroll mesh



5.

Use a cable ties to hold the edges of the mesh to the wire frame all the way around the balcony



Trim excess cable tie

Ensure cable ties are pulled TIGHT

6.

Trim any excess mesh

7.

Finally check there are **no gaps anywhere**
